

As many will know, four Mannofield members are also working as Aberdeen Street Pastors and are part of a volunteer organisation has been in existence in Aberdeen for over 15 years. ASP have around 100 volunteers working on Friday and Saturday nights throughout the year, typically from around 10pm to 4am the following morning, generally in teams of 6-8. In those years ASP have offered over 45,000 hours of help, and more than 10,000 people have

visited our 'SafeSpace' truck, parked in Union Street, at the heart of the night-time economy. The 7-tonne truck, as the name suggests, offers a welcoming and safe place where people can come for help, a chat or some tea/coffee and sometimes to charge a mobile phone!

We enjoy helping and are on the receiving end of countless 'High Fives' and grateful thanks. It's a privilege to be part of this, extending Jesus' love to all in a practical way.
