Dear Friends.

And just like that we reach the season of Advent and Christmas!

I don't know about you but with all that is going on in our hectic lives and in the world I was somewhat unprepared for the arrival of the Season when the first Christmas Adverts hit our Radio and TV. However, with a quick shake down – the only thing to do is to delve in and get into the Spirit of the Season – lest we get the reputation for being too much like one of two well-known seasonal characters: AKA - Scrooge or The Grinch.

Amidst the fun, frivolity, and indulgences of the Season, for us there is a key message to absorb. There are many ways to describe the message. I don't suppose that they expected the solution to be a tiny baby, born into a poor family in an insignificant backwater of the Roman Empire. None of the prophets lived to see this happen, yet they trusted that God would keep his word, and used this as their basis of encouraging others not just to believe, but to act in ways that would shape this new world built on God's vision of Peace.

It can be hard to hold onto a promise when we cannot see it happening, but that is what hope is all about. It's what this Season of Christmas offers us.

It brings us something to '<u>Hope in'</u>, and an incentive to be people of Faith who '<u>bring this Hope</u>' to others.

"Therefore, the Lord himself will give you a sign: The young woman will conceive and give birth to a son and will call him Immanuel". Isaiah 7:14

God indeed is with us. In this Truth, we find our Hope!

May the Season bring you much fun, happiness, and joy and may it be full of words, moments and signs that leave you with great reason to be one of those able to live in a Spirit of Hope.
